Fundación para la Atención Integral ANCLA ("ANCHOR") is a non-profit organization that works to build, strengthen, and "anchor" a sexual health care model in the region with a differential, vulnerability, and gender approach that enables a comprehensive model for all, with a special focus on high-impact populations. It also works to strengthen and "anchor" the combined prevention methodology in the region as an effective strategy for the care and elimination of HIV and other STIs, through educational processes in health promotion and disease prevention.

We have supported this group since 2020.

During 2022:

GSK provided 106,952,600 COP (£21,871) of funding to support part of a collaborative project to improve and unify knowledge and create awareness around the concepts of quality of life, U=U and Adherence. Working with a network of PAGS in LATAM (Mexico, Brazil, Argentina, Chile and Peru), ANCLA facilitated working groups with the final objective of creating a consensus for the implementation of actions that incorporate these concepts within the projects.

Our support represented 5% of their overall income in 2022.

SENOSama Foundation

The SENOSama Foundation is a private non-profit foundation that has an interdisciplinary team to help women and their families cope with breast, uterine and ovarian cancer. The SENOSama Foundation guides, supports, and accompanies patients and families diagnosed with breast, uterine and ovarian cancer to improve their quality of life. It carries out educational activities in the general population aimed at self-care, prevention and early detection of the disease and represents the community in public policy scenarios supported by research results in breast, uterine, and ovarian cancer.

We have supported this group since 2022.

During 2022:

GSK provided 7,004,340 COP (£1,432) of funding to support the development of a webinar about ovarian cancer aimed at the general Spanish-speaking population with access to the Internet. This activity was part of the "ME CUIDO Y ME CUIDAS" educational project of the foundation, which aims to educate different audiences on issues related to cancer such as prevention, risks, early detection, diagnosis, treatment, survival and end-of-life care.

Our support represented 1.23% of their overall income in 2022.

Corporación Red Somos

Corporación Red Somos is a community-based organization in Colombia founded in 2007 that works for the recognition of sexual and gender diversity, sexual health and community strengthening, through the provision of community services, social research, participation and advocacy policy. They work with groups and populations in a context of vulnerability, particularly people from the LGBTIQ+ social sectors and people living with HIV. Recognizing the phenomenon of mixed migratory flows in Colombia, their work and actions have extended to LGBTIQ+ migrants, refugees and returnees living with HIV.

We have supported this group since 2018.

During 2022:

GSK provided 89,808,000 COP (£18,365) of funding to support the implementation of different continuing medical education activities aimed at strengthening the U=U concept and achieving the commitment of community, health and government actors in Colombia. Additionally, the funding supported the promotion of networking in 4 Latin American countries on the topic U=U within the framework of combined prevention.

Our support represented 5% of their overall income in 2022.
