<u>IGCS</u> is a non-governmental organisation whose mission is to enhance the care of those with gynaecologic cancers worldwide through education, training, public awareness, and advocacy so that every individual under every circumstance receives the best possible quality of care and quality of life, resulting in the best outcomes. IGCS has assembled an Advocacy Committee to oversee the International Gynaecologic Cancer Advocacy Network (IGCAN), which covers three areas:

- Patient Education and Awareness
- Advocacy Research and Science
- Collaboration and Network Building

We have supported this group since 2020.

During 2022:

GSK provided 105,000 USD of funding to support:

Our support represented 5.8% of their overall income in 2022.

- Gynaecologic Cancer Global Advocacy Network (90,525 USD)
